Hi Lino and Ferdy,

Well, I just received the leaf cutter bee lab results back an hour ago, and I couldn't be more pleased. I will prepare a full summary for both tests and send it to you next week, but here's the highlights.....

Reece harvested the bees without me there (I wanted as impartial of a test as possible) and recorded 4 scores: Honey production, chalkbrood, overall health and frames of bees.

The big news was the PIP in the water tank test.

- a) This seems to jive with what PIP does. Improve the bee health and everything improves.
- b) Honey production was 33.7% higher than the control...!!! (sorry, exclamation points are due here..!)
- c) Health (a subjective score by Reece [Reece us the owner of the huge hive company]) was 24.7% higher..!
- d) and frames of bees (bee replication) was 31.9% higher!
- e) In the leaf cutter test, we extracted the bees last week and sent a sample to the lab. We were trying to lower chalkbrood and boy did we succeed.
- f) Total chalkbrood [**Chalkbrood**, a fungal brood disease of honey bees], (sporulating and nonsporulating) in the treated bees was .67%. This is a very low number considering where we started. The control sample was 1.24%. We dropped the chalkbrood to 54% of control! I am just stoked.
